It's off to the Italian Dolomites in 2007 - Cortina is located in the heart of South Tyrol and is famous for its sunshine, fresh air and spectacular scenery. With a base elevation of 4015 ft. rising to 10640 ft, Cortina provides access to 87 miles of beginner (33%), intermediate (62%), and expert (5%) skiing terrain.

Stay at the 4**** **Parc Hotel Victoria**, owned and managed since 1892 by the Angeli Family, is well known for the warm and welcoming ambiance. Centrally located, at the beginning of the pedestrian area, it has spacious lounges, furnished with local antiques, an ancient Stube equipped with different games, pool, a reading room with library and Internet, comfortable and personalized rooms (almost all with balcony) and an excellent restaurant with a first-class wine menu.
